WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

We are looking for a Business Intelligence Developer. The Business Intelligence Developer is responsible for translating business requirements into efficient & sustainable data warehouse solutions and to deliver these as part of the agile development lifecycle. He/she will be mainly responsible for those BI products requiring strong stakeholder engagement such as business wide key performance indicators. He/she ensures that the BI solutions align to the overall data warehouse architecture.

WHICH TEAM WILL YOU JOIN?

This role is within the Data department and reports to the Data Management Lead.

Previously, this department was known as 'BI', or Business Intelligence, but these days, it's really all about data — although enabling intelligent business decisions is certainly one of our main goals. However, apart from reporting and analytics, we also take care of regulatory reporting, data governance and the maintenance of our Datawarehouse, the "MIDB".

As data is a concept with many aspects, it's no surprise we have many different types of skills, personalities and indeed, nationalities, in our department. We have developers, engineers, architects, analysts, project managers, subject matter experts... Just to name a few. Moreover, we are distributed across multiple countries.

WHO ARE YOU AND WHAT DO WE ASK FROM YOU?

- Engage with stakeholders to capture reporting requirements mainly in the area of key performance indicators
- Explain technical challenges to users and create workable solutions together with business stakeholders
- Design and develop efficient and sustainable data warehouse solutions with stakeholder requirements
- Manage the development route to live by implementing his/her work packages into the various test environments and into the live environment, and maintain BI products throughout their lifecycle of deployment, enhancement and support
- Validate data warehouse solution designs from third party provider with regards to overall architecture principles, efficiency and maintainability
- Coordinate the development of data warehouse changes and reports (when applicable together with onshore and offshore developers) in an agile (scrum) team
- On an ad-hoc basis support the daily ETL process and any required fixes



- Engage with other architects in the bank to align data warehouse development with overall architecture strategy
- Ensure adherence to development standards and processes within Lloyds Bank NL and Lloyds Banking Group
- Continuously drive the product development within BI with regards to data provisioning from the data warehouse, reports, analytical solutions and data visualisation with a focus on business needs, innovation and efficiency in order to enable data-driven management and self service BI
- Proven longstanding experience with the use of SQL Server 2016 (or above) and development tools (visual studio, versioning, TFS, urban code)
- Advanced understanding of data warehouse architecture, the ETL process, dimensional modelling and end to end reporting solutions
- Experience with Datawarehouse testing
- Collaborative way of working; experience in managing teams or working in agile teams is a plus
- Fluent within English language
- Educated to a Bachelor's degree in Business studies and/or IT
- Relevant work experience in reporting area of 2-5 years
