# **BUSINESS ANALYST (ADT)**

### **WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?**

We are looking for a Business Analyst. The Business Analyst will be working within one of the Agile Delivery (Feature) Teams, which facilitates the delivery of changes across the bank. He/ she gathers and validates business needs and translates them into documented requirements. Furthermore, the BA collaborates with suppliers/ developers to perform analysis on system capabilities and creates gap analyses. For new Requests for Change (RfC's), the BA performs assessments to provide high-level impact estimations and potential solution scenario's. Close cooperation with the business, developers, suppliers and other stakeholders is key.

The BA has relevant experience within a BA role and preferably has knowledge of Mortgages and/or Personal Loans. As part of a self-organising team the BA is capable and comfortable to contribute beyond the own realm of expertise, eager to learn new skills and embraces an agile way of working.

### **WHICH TEAM WILL YOU JOIN?**

As a Business Analyst you are part of the Change Team NL. Our team consists of approximately 18 colleagues. The Change Team NL colleagues work in different roles, like Project managers, PMO, Quality Assurance/ Process Manager(s), Business Analysts and Scrum Masters. Chantal Engels is the Line Manager of this team. We support many changes across the organisation. On a daily basis we work in smaller Delivery (Feature) Teams together with colleagues from other departments. The Change team NL is part of the department Marketing & Business Development NL, led by Tom Starink.

### **WHO ARE YOU AND WHAT DO WE ASK FROM YOU?**

- Collaborate with the business through elicitation sessions to ensure full understanding and appropriate documentation of business needs
- Translate business needs into concrete user stories, elaborate on them within refinement sessions and manage them throughout their lifecycle in JIRA
- Carry out impact assessments, create/ modify business process flows, perform process analyses to develop and validate solutions
- Deliver backlog items to expected quality, from creation and estimation until testing and implementation. This includes:
  - Identification of any issues that may affect delivery in advance and seeking solutions to rectify.
  - Take informed decisions required for delivery together with the team
- Supports the Product Owner with managing the backlog, e.g. the definition of epics/ user stories and clarification of detailed requirements with input from stakeholders
- Work closely with suppliers as well as colleagues in different locations

- Comfortable to support the team by picking up tasks beyond the own realm of expertise
- Participate in all relevant Agile/ Scrum ceremonies such as the Sprint planning, Daily stand ups, Refinement sessions, Sprint reviews and Retrospectives
- Bachelor's or Master's degree in Business studies
- >3 years relevant work experience within BA role
- Experience working in the Dutch Financial Sector is a plus
- Analytical and structured with good attention to detail, whilst also capable of seeing the bigger picture.
- Pro-active with strong analytical process-design and problem-solving skills
- Dynamic with ability to learn and use new skills and knowledge in varying circumstances.
- Able to develop strong working relationships and work collaboratively within the team as well as across organizational levels
- Able to answer complex questions in a structured and clear way and then communicate to stakeholders/ suppliers
- Familiar with putting Agile and/or Scrum principles into practice.
- Knowledge of and experience with Mortgages and/or Personal Loans is a plus; from product features to key processes and main IT systems/ suppliers
- Relevant Business Analyst certifications such as ECBA, CCBA and CBAP are a plus
- Strong oral and written communication skills in Dutch and English
- Flexible, able to act in many and diverse situations
- Problem solving skills, able to cope with resistance
- Conceptual thinking
- Result oriented
- Pro-active attitude
- Team player
